TSO Music Camp, held at Camp Bickell for over ten years, offers a unique experience where campers, ages 8 to 18, can enjoy challenging music, balanced with exciting recreational activities. The TSO Music Camp is committed to providing excellence in program, safety, supervision and leadership.



Camp Bickell, located off Municipal Rd. on Chapman Lake, 70 km from Timmins, has all the modern amenities a camp can provide. It boasts a spectacular main lodge, comfortable sleeping quarters, indoor washrooms and hot showers. All cabins have a counsellor living in to supervise and assist with daily camp routines.

Nutritious meals are served in the impressive new Dining Hall. Cooking staff can accommodate most dietary restrictions with ease. We are very careful and adaptable when dealing with allergies or food-related medical conditions. In addition to three meals daily, snacks are served. Parents and friends are welcome to join us for lunch/dinner. Please note a nominal fee of \$8 is charged per guest.

The Camp has a tuck shop where campers can purchase treats during reception time. A maximum of \$3 a day is allowed and must be prepaid upon arrival. Any unused money could be returned to the camper or donated to the TSO.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Medical personnel will be on site at all times. Waterfront staff are certified lifeguards and are on duty at all swimming times. Students are not allowed near the dock unless attended by a lifeguard. Any medications must be left with the camp medic. Parents please leave a contact name and number where you can be reached at all times in case of emergency.

DAY AT A GLANCE

Our camp is very active and diverse, structured so that each student has 2/3 music and 1/3 recreation. Each morning and afternoon, campers receive music instruction, interspersed with craft and recreational activities. The week culminates in a skit night where campers and staff relax before the final concert on Saturday.
